Checklist for Programs Applying for Initial Accreditation

Dear Program Representatives:

We are happy you are moving forward with accreditation in this upcoming cycle. The following is important information regarding next steps and deadlines.

The following process must be followed by an institution seeking initial accreditation with the National Environmental Health Science & Protection Accreditation Council (EHAC). EHAC will consider accrediting an Environmental Health program that has met the following:

____ The program has graduated one or more classes under the curriculum being evaluated for accreditation.

____ The Program has submitted a Program Evaluation Report (Self-Study) with supporting materials. **Please contact the EHAC office current deadline.**

____ The program has submitted a completed Application Form and Payment of applicable fees by **(please contact office for current deadline)**. Fees are \$750 for new programs and \$300 for programs that already have an EHAC accredited program and are seeking accreditation for an additional program.

After these requirements have been completed, a site visit team assigned by the Council will conduct a site visit at the institution. The Council will evaluate the application materials and site visit report at its Annual Council Meeting which is held in conjunction with the National Environmental Health Association's Annual Education Conference each summer.
